The board accepted the recommendations of the Hearing and Assessment Panel.

The Board resolved:


1. That the complaint against Jennifer Forman (Elliott) is upheld and the matter constitutes a breach of the Code of Conduct under Clause 2.

b) Professional misconduct

defined as:

- 'conduct which involves a substantial or consistent failure to reach or maintain a reasonable standard of competence and diligence'; or
 - conduct happening in connection with the practice of Nutrition and Dietetics or otherwise that would, if established, justify a finding that the practitioner is not a fit and proper person to continue to be a member of the Association and engage in Dietetic practice.
2. The Board imposes the sanction of expulsion from membership of the DAA and the APD program.
 3. The Board supports the recommendation that the *Constitution* allows DAA to alert relevant authorities such as Medicare, DVA, health funds and relevant government departments. Your status will also be noted on the public section of the DAA website.
